- Conducting training for multipliers and people working with former prisoners.
- Increasing the competences of people working with former prisoners by participating in the training and developing a cooperation network.
- Obtaining precise knowledge about the needs of people working with former inmates through research on professional competences in the field of verbal and nonverbal communication.

The project is innovative due to the use of innovative methods of communication and support, such as Rollnick Miller's motivational dialogue (MIRM) and coaching, in the area of work with people leaving prisons.

The project partnership includes four organizations from Poland, Germany and Lithuania that have experience in the field of adult education and training and in working with people at risk of social exclusion.
